Hello;

I would like to start by thanking all of our school parents who have been so patient and understanding with our new illness protocols: thank you for being able to promptly come to the school and pick up your child when they are sick, thank you for keeping them home until they are healthy, and thank you for being so understanding with us as this is something we have to do in order to try keep us all healthy.

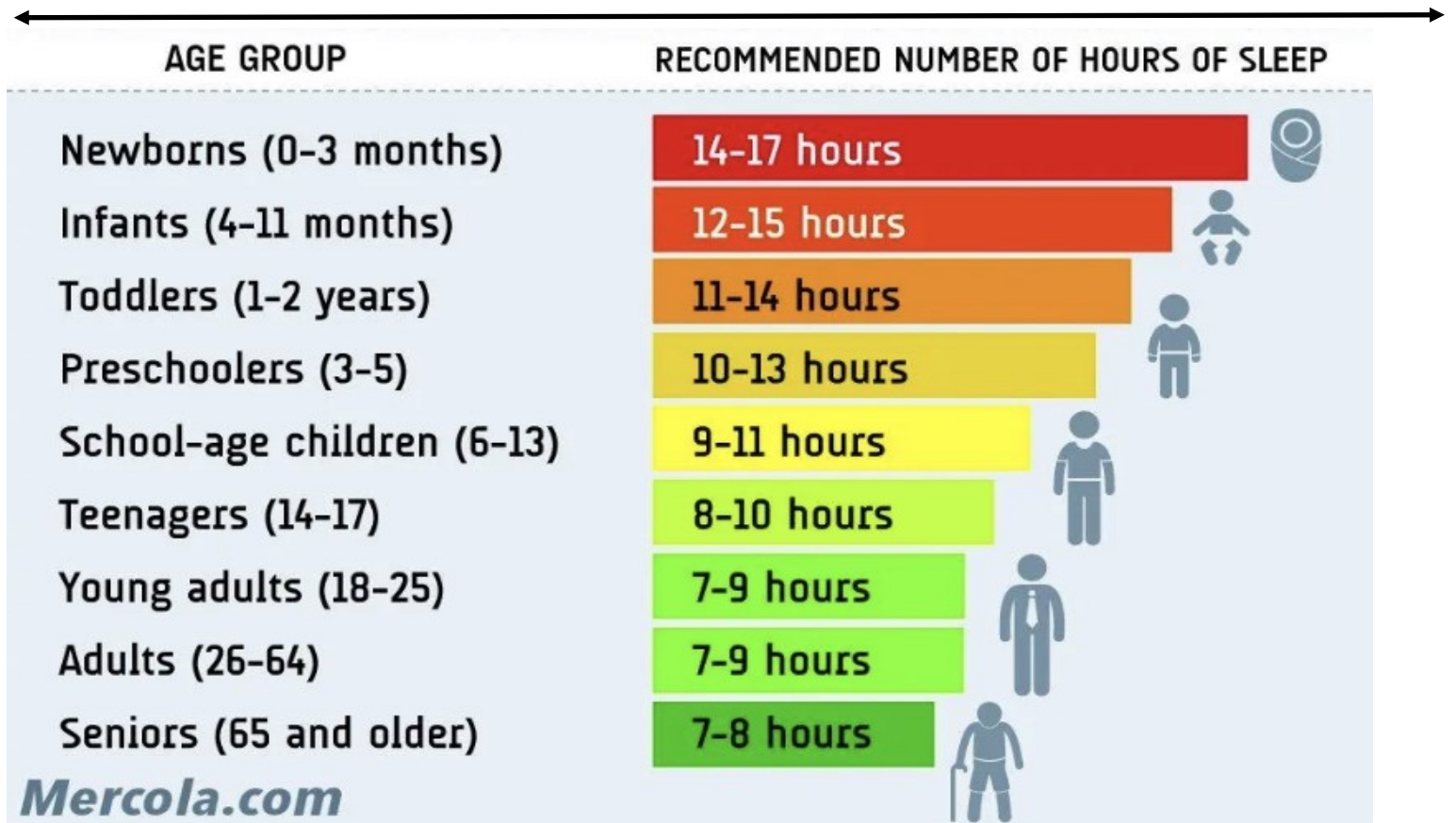

NEW CERTIFICATION REQUIRED BY ALL HOCKEY TEAM OFFICIALS

Due to the current Covid-19 situation, Hockey Canada has developed an online course to *ensure hockey volunteers have as much information as possible to prepare for the return to hockey. For the 2020-21 hockey season, ALL REGISTERED TEAM OFFICIALS are required to complete the Hockey University: Planning a Safe Return to Hockey course.* The online course is roughly 20 minutes long and looks at some key information our membership needs to know to help to reduce the risk of COVID-19 in the hockey environment. Throughout this free online course, it will refer to detailed information on specific prevention topics and encourage all to become familiar with the Public Health Authority guidelines/restrictions and the Hockey Canada Safety Guidelines. There is no charge for Hockey Canada registered hockey volunteers to access the Hockey University course.
