STUDENT-LED CONFERENCES

Student-led conferences provide parents with updates on their child's progress and opportunities to see their children's work. They also open communication between school and home. In the student-led conference format, students and teachers prepare together, and then students lead the conference while teachers facilitate. The triad then sits together to review and discuss the work and the student's progress. The message is that students are responsible for their own success. This is the student's moment to share his or her reflections on achievements and challenges.

We are required by Prairie South Schools to conduct 2 student led conferences and report the participation results.
