Listed below you will find our school goals for the 2016-2017 school year:

Student Learning Goals:

By June 2017, 90% of grades 1 to 3 students at Caronport Elementary will comprehend at grade level what they read as measured by Fountas and Pinnell (grades 1-3).

By June 2020, 80% of grades 4 to 8 students at Caronport Elementary participating in provincial assessments will be at or above grade level in writing.

Student Wellness Goal:

By June 2017, CES students reporting moderate to higher levels of anxiety will be reduced by 10% as indicated by the TTFM results.

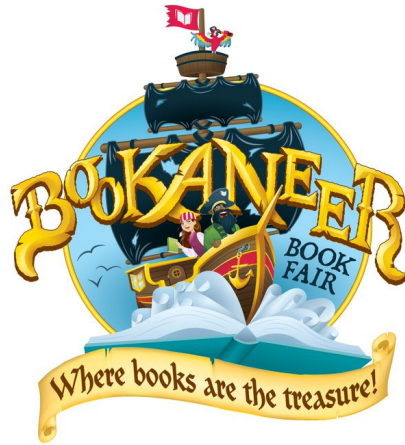
