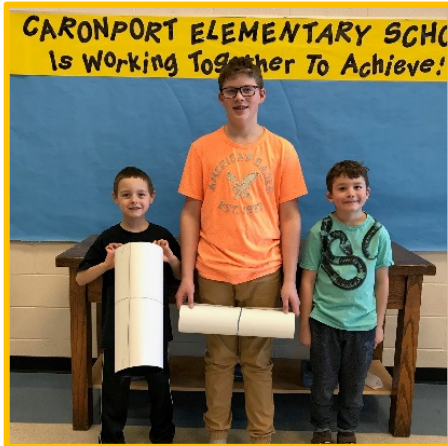

There have been some questions about pinworms. Please read the attached sheet for information on signs, symptoms and prevention.

School Attendance:

Did you know? Research shows that missing 18 days in most school divisions, negatively affects a student's academic performance. That's just two days a month and that's known as chronic absence. Some students are missing so many days of school that they are academically at risk. Chronic absence can translate into children in grade three unable to master reading and falling levels of reading behind, students in grade six failing subjects, and students in grade nine dropping out of high school. When students improve their attendance rates, they improve their academic prospects and chances for graduating. Absenteeism in the first month of school can predict poor attendance throughout the school year. Half the students who miss 2-4 days in September go on to miss nearly a month of school in an academic year. We want parents to ensure their children get the best start in school and in life as possible.
