Provincial Dental Screening

A Dental Health Educator will be at **Caronport Elementary School** to provide a visual dental screening for grade 1 and 7 students on **Friday February 1st, 2019**.

This screening does not replace your regular dental checkups. The screening is a quick visual look at your child's mouth. The Provincial Dental Screening is done every 5 years for grade 1 and 7 students throughout the province of Saskatchewan. The information collected is used to assess the oral health of children in Saskatchewan and to direct planning/development of preventive program services for your community/school. A note will be sent home following the screening.
