Why the importance of reducing screen time in young children?

There is no doubt that human interaction has a strong influence on language development. Language development and vocabulary growth in young children are directly related to the amount of time parents spend speaking to them. Too much screen time can interfere with language development because parents spend less time interacting with and talking to their child. Also, children who have certain types of language delays by age 5 are at risk for social and emotional delays in adulthood.

Research shows that for every hour of television watched, children hear 500 to 1000 fewer words. In addition, children who are regularly exposed to 2 hours of screen time per day are 3 to 5 times more likely to develop a language delay. The American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) recommends no screen time for children 18-24 months and a maximum of 1 hour per day of high quality screen time for children ages 2 to 5 because of the potential harm to the developing brain.
