Student Led Conferences

Many teachers and parents speak enthusiastically about the benefits of student-led conferences. Student-led conferences help students take on that responsibility to own their learning, reflect on what they have learned, and set goals for themselves. Caronport Elementary is offering two approaches to the conferences. One approach is a private conference with a fifteen-minute limit while the other is a station approach where the family has a half hour or one hour slot of time where they can flexibly manage it to their needs. Either approach is meant to be a celebration of student growth and development. If teachers or parents have any concerns, we encourage them to discuss these when they occur and not wait until the Student Led Conferences.
