BABYSITTING BASICS

The St. John Ambulance (SJA) Babysitting Basics class was developed by a team of childcare professionals, trained babysitters, SJA instructors, and parents. This course teaches new babysitters the skills necessary to care for infants, toddlers, and preschoolers. It emphasizes safety, dealing with emergencies, and first aid basics.

Course materials include a study activity book, a certificate suitable for framing, and a wallet size card.

Key concepts taught in this course include becoming a babysitter, caring for children, children and food, keeping children safe, children and play, babysitter wellbeing, handling emergencies, and first aid and health related emergencies.
