HOME ALONE

The Home Alone course is designed by the Canadian Safety Council for the 10 to 14-year-old group. The course helps prepare students deal with unforeseen emergencies and allows them to stay safe in times where they may find themselves alone for short periods of time.

Key concepts taught in this course include how to deal with phone calls and visitors, recognizing hazards, and following home safety procedures. They will also learn first aid basics, fire safety, and how and when to use 911.
