BABYSITTING BASICS

The St. John Ambulance (SJA) Babysitting Basics class was developed by a team of childcare professionals, trained babysitters, SJA instructors, and parents. This course teaches new babysitters the skills necessary to care for infants, toddlers, and preschoolers. It emphasizes safety, dealing with emergencies, and first aid basics.

Course materials include a study activity book, a certificate suitable for framing, and a wallet size card.

Key concepts taught in this course include becoming a babysitter, caring for children, children and food, keeping children safe, children and play, babysitter wellbeing, handling emergency and first aid and health related emergencies.

The course is for kids that are 11 years or older, and the cost is \$40/student.

HOME ALONE

The Home Alone course is designed by the Canadian Safety Council for the 10 to 14-year-old group. The course helps prepare students deal with unforeseen emergencies and allows them to stay safe in times where they may find themselves alone for short periods of time.

Key concepts taught in this course include how to deal with phone calls and visitors, recognizing hazards, and following home safety procedures. They will also learn first aid basics, fire safety, and how and when to use 911.
