The ways in which you are helping us are:

- ensuring students arrive no earlier than 8:50 am & 12:25 pm,
- ensuring students arrive home at days-end. (With the exciting return of the Gaga ball pits, students from mixed cohorts are tempted to come early or to stay later which can make it very tricky for the school as we are responsible for their safe return home and have been asking them to respect the cohort system. It also makes it tricky because we do not have supervisors outside before and after school but end up having after school issues and/or injuries due to the lack of parental supervision. While we love to have them here, we ask the same thing we do with the rink in the winter in that they go home after school and come back with parent permission/supervision.)
- making lunch at home a priority,
- dressing them in weather appropriate attire,
- keeping your children at home when they are not feeling well,
- picking your children up quickly when they feel ill at school,
- phoning 811 to follow their advice,
- keeping belongings at home,
- following the guidance of public health officials at home as cases continue to rise in the province

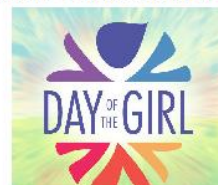

## What Do I Do when My Child is Sick?

Thank you for your support in September! Just as a reminder, according to the Administrative Procedure 164 – Appendix C (see Attached for Full Document) we are to follow the following procedures:

### 2. Guidelines for Illness

2.1 All students are expected to self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms. Common symptoms include:

• Fever	• Cough
• Headache	• Muscle and/or joint aches and pains
• Sore throat	• Chills
• Runny nose	• Nasal congestion
• Conjunctivitis	• Dizziness
• Fatigue	• Nausea/vomiting
• Diarrhea	• Loss of appetite
• Loss of sense of taste or smell	• Shortness of breath
• Difficulty breathing	

2.2 If a student has symptoms of COVID-19 illness they are to stay home and call Healthline 811. The student shall follow the recommendations and directions provided.

2.3 The student should stay home for 48 hours after symptoms have resolved or when they receive a negative test result; whichever is longer.

2.6 Parents or guardians shall follow the direction of the Saskatchewan Health Authority following the use of the Saskatchewan COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool before the student returns to school.
