School Arrival

Students will not be allowed to access the playground before the start of school. Students are to be at school between 8:30-8:45. Students will be assigned designated doors to enter the building. Each door has a sanitization station.

Lunch & Nutrition

We have extended our lunch break from 12:20-1:10. If students are able, they are encouraged to leave the building over the lunch hour. There will be no access to canteen, microwaves, and daycare meal program (for non-daycare students). Students will be delivered a nutrition snack daily.

Dismissal

We are asking that parents/guardians wait outside (parking lot or side street) to pick up their child(ren). All exterior doors to the school will be locked except for the main entrance between 8:45-4:00.

Masks

Due to the number of students entering and exiting our building, masks will be a requirement for students Grades 3-12 as they enter, leave and travel in the hallways and common areas (washrooms, library, computer lab.) Students grades Pre-Kindergarten- Grade 2 will not be required to wear a mask but school staff will support students wanting to wear a mask. As per the directives sent out by Prairie South last week, masks must be worn in all locations occupied by 15 or more people (at Coronach School this is all classes).

Entering and Exiting the Building

To minimize contact between student cohorts, when entering the building students should report directly to their morning or afternoon classes. There will be no before, noon, or afterschool programming, so students are expected to leave the building following dismissal.

Public Access

Currently, we are limiting public access inside the building and require visitors to sign in and wear a mask. We strongly encourage the use of phone or email to contact the school. Meetings will be scheduled virtually.



The school sent out a letter earlier in August indicating that the school would be purchasing school supplies for the students to start the new school year. We ask that the minimal be brought to school. For math courses a calculator will need to be purchased. For Physical Education classes appropriate gym wear and indoor shoes should be brought to school.

My School Sask (MSS)

The student and parent portals have been opened for the 2020-2021 school year. Parent and student logins will remain the same but passwords will be reset. Emails with updated password were sent out earlier this month. Please contact the school if you are having difficulty accessing MSS.

School Fees

Normal school activity fees will be collected by the school. Each student (Pre-Kindergarten-Grade 12) will be required to pay \$15.00. You can pay fees by cash, cheque (payable to Coronach School), or online at https://prairiesouth.schoolcashonline.com/

Under Construction

Emotional Support...

Children will respond to the transition back to school in different ways, and each of our classrooms will have additional programming to support children who have been away from school since March. Let us know if your child is having a difficult transition back to school. We can help!

Responding to Illness...

Children or staff who are sick will not be allowed at school until they have been symptom free for 48 hours or are confirmed to be COVID-19 negative. Our school has an isolation room and PPE available in the event

that a child gets sick while at school. Through our Superintendent, we are working with the Saskatchewan Health Authority to ensure testing is available when needed.

Focus on Hygiene...

All of our washrooms with air dryers have had paper towel added so that students can practice safe hand washing. Every classroom has its own supply of hand sanitizer in addition to the personal bottles that students will bring, and our teachers will be implementing regular hand hygiene practices in every room. Hand hygiene before and after activities will ensure the safety of our students and staff.

Grades 7-8: students will use front of school main entrance (north entrance) Grades 9-12: students will use student parking entrance (east entrance)

3. Pick-Up and Drop-Off Procedures:

Students will need to sign out/in at the office before leaving or entering the building outside of regular schedule. Students will leave/enter school through the main entrance (north entrance). All other doors will remain locked. Parents are being asked to communicate with the school by calling the main office and stay outside when picking up or dropping off students.

4. Supervision – Playground/Shared Spaces.

Students will remain in their student cohorts and supervisors will be present. Additional supervision at doors will be present (to reduce physical contact).

 Storage Areas/Lockers;
 Each student (Gr PreK-6) will be assigned a separate classroom storage cubby or large plastic closed container so that personal items are separate from other students Each student (Gr 7-12) will be assigned a top and bottom locker and school lock for personal items.

8. Nutrition Programs:

Students will receive a nutrition snack daily during first period. Snacks will be delivered to each cohort by their first period teacher.

9. Lunch/Microwaves/Canteen/Daycare Lunches:

It is recommended that students go home for lunch. Students who are unable to go home for lunch will be eating lunch in their homeroom classroom. The school canteen, the use of microwaves, and daycare lunch program (for non daycare students) will not be accessible to students.
