Section One. Students.

- The Government of Saskatchewan has announced the indefinite suspension of classes for PreK-12 students beginning Friday, March 20th.
- Grades 8-12 students may remain at school today but are not able to attend beginning tomorrow with the exception of students who are unable to care for themselves independently.
- Parents who are able to make arrangements for childcare are to stop sending their children to school immediately. No students will be allowed at school beginning on Friday, March 20th.

Section Two. All School and School Division Staff.

- All staff will continue to report to work as they do regularly up to and including Thursday, March 19th. Direction related to staff attendance after March 19th will follow.
- All information shared yesterday related to self-monitoring, self-isolating, and travel continues to be in effect.

Section Three. Schools.

- Prairie South transportation services will continue as regularly scheduled up to and including Thursday, March 19th.
- We are working on a plan to ensure ongoing learning opportunities for students and families who choose to access them during the time that classes are suspended.
