1. Leadership - Please outline areas of leadership that you demonstrate in your family, school, community and with your friends/peer group.

2. Responsibilities outside the school - What takes your time and energy outside of school, how important are these responsibilities to you and what impact does this have on you and others?

3. Financial Support Needed - The need for financial support must be demonstrated (you may be solely supporting yourself, have other family members dependent on you for financial support or may have limited or no ability to earn extra money given current circumstances). How would the scholarship help you achieve your academic goals?

4. Academic Performance - You must demonstrate a level of academic performance that makes graduation from Grade 12 likely. Please highlight your plans for completing the academic requirements to attain Grade 12 and move on to Post- Secondary education.
