

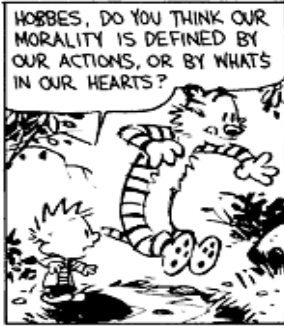


MORTLACH SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

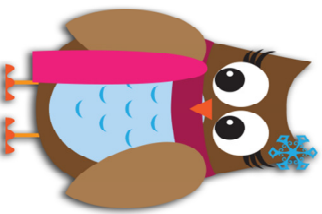
