1. Principal Report (Jon McLean & Nadine Elder)

Heritage Fair

2. PSSD Board Report (Tim McLeod & Mary Jukes)

- Recap that Prairie South received 7.5 Million additional dollars for this year's budget, which results in approximately \$291,000 for Prairie South School Division.
- Division Wide additions across 9 schools: 3.5 FTE teachers, 7.0 FTE EAs, .5 FTE Early Learning Consultant, all schools with a single Facility Operator will get immediate staff replacement when the FO is absent, additional AA support to support the new SIS software.

3. Teacher Report (Andrew Gallagher)

Suggestion to have a Clothing Drive at the School

- Good idea, some logistics to sort out as to what specific type of clothing the drive is looking for (ex. Winter outdoor gear, versus all types of clothing).
- Need to consider how to display. Tables versus hanging them on clothes racks.
 - o May be an option to get hangers from cleaners in town
- Suggest to do it in the fall before Winter and on a Saturday.
- Discussion narrowed it down to: Just Fall/Winter clothing in October sometime.
