1. Principal Report

MySchool Sask Update

- Palliser are approaching a point where the parent portal will be open soon.
- Students in the high school program was enabled last week and Palliser will be testing it starting this week with Parent log ins to be tested next
 - o This year will be a learning year.
 - o We are one of the initial schools using this system.
 - o Patience while we work through the bugs
 - o Stay tuned for information.
- Every parent K-8 will have a log in. Parents will be able to see assessments by date.
- The new system will continue to use the 4-point scale, thought different that what is being used now.
 - o May affect how the leveling affects the “range of percentage”. For example, there are more outcome-based levels so a student that may have been a “4” previously, could be a “3” this year.
 - o There will be an information session available to all parents once it gets rolled out.
- Focus is to get the Math and ELA outcomes in the program first

LIP Update

- Reminder that this year’s goals are writing and math
- November: there will be a data collection for both math and writing for ALL students from grades 1-8.
 - o First time that they will be graded on their writing based on the 4-level ministry rubric
 - o Ministry will collect for grades 4 & 7 only
 - o Palliser is aiming to get ALL grades in order to better track our LIP process
