1. Principal Report

Haunted House

MySchool Sask Update

- As mentioned in the past, this year is a learning year while the system is still in development
- All parents should have received the email to access report cards.

- Currently, they should see the attendance information, when assignments are posted and the report cards. Academics are not linked yet.
- The Ministry of Education are the ones developing this app and are working on fixing some IT bugs as there are still some small glitches to sort out.

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2. PSSD Board Report

- Provincial ministry evaluates every school based on capacity and utilization based on capacity.
- Palliser has the largest enrollment in the division, and a utilization rating of 89%
- There are a several schools in the division that are at a utilization rate of 20-30%.
- There are factors that play into the calculation that skew the stats. For example, Peacock High School has to calculate the space of the shops, etc...
- To be considered for a portable classroom, the school needs to be at 135-140% capacity rate

3. Teacher Report
