Hello Parents/Guardians:

I am writing today to provide additional information regarding vaccination opportunities for students aged 12 years of age and older. Prairie South is providing administrative support to Public Health in their initiative to provide vaccination opportunities for as many students as possible by the end of the school year.

Public Health has notified us that a vaccination clinic for school-aged (12 and older) students will be held at the **Exhibition Grounds in Moose Jaw on June 3, 2021 from 8:30 am to 7:30 pm.** Please read the attached information provided by Public Health carefully. Consent forms may be taken directly to the clinic; there is no need to return them to the school. If you did not receive a consent form, you may download one at <https://www.saskatchewan.ca/covid19-youth-vaccine> or complete one at the clinic where they will be available.

In order to reduce congestion, the following times are recommended for specific schools:

8:30 am – noon: Students 12 and older from Central Collegiate, Peacock Collegiate, Riverview Collegiate, Briercrest Christian Academy, Mortlach School, Chaplin School, Central Butte School, Eyebrow School, Huron Colony, Craik School, Avonlea School, Rouleau School, Mossbank School, Belle Plaine Colony School, Baildon Colony School

noon – 7:30 pm: Students 12 and older from Caronport Elementary School, King George School, Sunningdale School, William Grayson School, École Palliser Heights School, Prince Arthur School, Westmount School, Empire School, Lindale School as well as students 12 and older who did not attend in the morning.

Vaccine supplies are limited, however Public Health is planning a follow-up student clinic on June 10th. As details become available about this, we will let you know.

Additional options are available for students who are home-schooled or who wish to access immunization sooner. These options include:

- Any [participating pharmacy](#) in Saskatchewan;
- By attending a [drive-thru or walk-in clinic](#) - note that these clinics will operate on reduced schedules in June in order to support school-based immunization during the week days;
