Students returning to Peacock 2019/2020 school year

TIMETABLES AND CLASS CHANGES: Students who require timetable changes should plan to see a counsellor prior to September 3, 2019. New students to the school, students with scheduling conflicts or with failed courses will be given first priority for timetabling. Class changes may also be done at this time. Please check our website for specific times and dates for appointments.

SCHOOL OPENING: All classes begin immediately after registration on Tuesday, September 4th at 8:44 a.m. Schedules will be available in the main office if you didn't receive an updated copy.

STUDENT FEES - \$50.00 (fee increase as of August 2018) fees are directed to the following: **Student Governance \$15.00** - activities include free BBQ's, spirit days, gym blasts, pep rallies, talent shows, special etc. **Athletic fee \$20.00** – activities include Intramurals, CORE Training, weight room, special event days; - free admission to all A.E. Peacock Collegiate games excluding Moose Jaw tournaments and play offs. **Fine Arts \$15.00** – Visual art club, Project 104; - also free admission to all Peacock student designated performances and productions including the Musical. Student fees are \$50.00 in total and are due by September 9 and can be paid by cash, cheque, or paid online this year using the link on our web site. An optional yearbook may be purchased at the same time for \$50.00 and is strongly encouraged.

DROPPING CLASSES: Grade 9 & 10 students **do not** drop classes and are expected to have full timetables. In Grade 11 & 12, when classes have been finalized, students can only drop classes **after** consultation with the subject teacher, parent, guidance counsellor and the administration.

ATTENDANCE MATTERS: If a student is absent from school parents are requested to make a call by 9:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. respectively, or leave a message on voice mail after school hours. *Students who wish to leave the school during the day must sign out in the main office and must have written or verbal (phoned) permission from a parent/guardian.

DRIVER EDUCATION: Students who are taking road tests over the summer, best of luck. Students who wish to take driver education in the fall, a signup sheet will be available in the office in September.

GET INVOLVED! The staff of Peacock believe that students should be involved in their school and we encourage students to participate in athletics, fine arts, and clubs! There will be a sign up in the main office during the first week of classes where students can register for activities. Generally speaking, students are able to participate in most activities as very few groups restrict enrolment. Interested in playing football this year?
