Dear Parents and Caregivers:

Following the Ministry of Education's announcement on June 18<sup>th</sup> that schools would be re-opening in September, Prairie South Schools staff have been planning for what the return to school will look like. The Ministry provided guidelines that need to be adapted to each school situation. As a result, three main priorities have been developed in Prairie South: *Student and Staff Health and Safety, Regular and Ongoing Contact with Families, and Teaching and Learning.*

In line with these priorities, three Prairie South high schools in Moose Jaw (Riverview Collegiate, A.E. Peacock Collegiate and Central Collegiate) have decided to alter the structure of curriculum delivery in semester one next year.

These schools will be implementing a block system in the first semester. The structure will look like this:

Block 1: September 1 – October 23

Morning: Class 1

Afternoon: Class 2

Block 2: October 27 – January 28

Morning: Class 3 & 4

Afternoon: Class 5

\*Lunch hour may change to accommodate the morning schedule\*

Each school will develop schedules based on what fits best in each environment. Courses will be scheduled based on already constructed timetables that students will have access to through MySchoolSask later this summer. Start times and break times will also be determined by the individual school. Should health restrictions ease we could return to a regular semester two schedule of five daily classes. However, the block system may be necessary and could continue through the second semester. More information will be communicated by Prairie South and the schools later in August.

Collectively we feel that this approach will best serve us in meeting the three priorities set out by the Ministry and Prairie South Schools. While we eagerly anticipate the return of our students this fall, we wish all our families a safe and restful summer.
