Please take note below if considering transferring to Virtual School:

- The Virtual School has no Chromebooks to lend out at this time, students will need to have a laptop/internet to take online classes (phones do not work, and tablets are not a recommended device).
- Internet which supports Zoom lessons is required.
- EAL students with a CFR level below B1.2 should not take online classes.
- Students who are independent learners typically do well in the virtual learning environment.
- EA assistance is not provided in the Virtual School.
- Elementary students taking online classes require an adult to be present/assist with the online classes (Parent/Guardian, Babysitter, Grandparent, etc)
- Attendance is taken in the AM and PM - students are required to attend Zoom lessons - attendance is mandatory. If students do not attend Zoom classes, they will be transferred back to the home school
