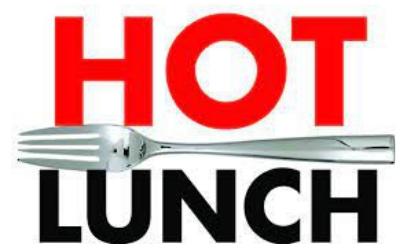
There is no school April 1 - 5 (Easter Break)

Student Pickup and Drop Off

We encourage anyone dropping off or picking up students from our school to **NOT** park on 4th Street East or use the north parking lot. Instead, we are asking that you park on either 7th Avenue East or Assiniboia Avenue.

The intent is to keep our students safe at very busy times of the school day. We often see students and parents jaywalking and our buses are not able to pull away freely or if using the north parking lot, students need to use that entrance and it could be a safety concern.

Accessing Report Cards in Parent (Family) Portal

1. After logging into **MySchoolSask** through the Parent (Family) portal, you will be sent to the **Home** screen.
2. Different headings such as **Welcome**, **Announcements**, **Published Reports** and **Recent Activity** will be shown.
3. In **Published Reports** (shown below), you will find progress reports that have been created and published (if they are not appearing, they may not be published yet). They will be available to **download** and/or **print**.

1. Log on to myschoolsask.ca	
2. Your page will look like this	
3. Run your finger along the left hand side of your screen. You may see a grey Home icon. Press on this.

6. It will take you to a screen that looks like this:	
7. Click on "Report Card - JC" under the "Published Reports" section. A new window will pop up with your child's report card.
