

## **ASCC Meeting Minutes**

**September 11th , 2019**

Christina calls the meeting to order. Christina read the notes from the last meeting. Lindsay adopts the minutes as read, seconded by Breanna.

### **Old Business:**

Discussion about the bills for the clean-up – make sure we reimburse Karley! The clean-up went well – we will consider doing this again.

Discussion about the new bell schedule. So far, the reception has been good. Candice shared some ideas to improve the canteen and other nutrition options during noon-hour and recesses. Discussion about hot lunch ideas. Maybe the SCC can sponsor/lead a hot-lunch program for the school. Discussion about hosting 1 hot-lunch per month and reaching out to the community to find supporters.

Discussion about the ‘alternate’ calendar. We are in the second year of our ‘trial’ – and its effectiveness will be reevaluated at the end of this year.

Discussion about whether or not to continue to support the Welcome-back BBQ. We would like to continue to support the BBQ by offering ‘man-power’, and we will discuss and develop this more in future meetings.

### **LIP:**

Discussion about the Learning Improvement Plan. Derrick directed the staff to make sure we align our school’s learning improvement plan to student learning and success. The staff will focus on supporting student learning via RTI (response to intervention) – the school goal is to have 75% of students meeting or exceeding outcomes by the end of the year. The staff will also consistently hold team meetings and PD to work together to develop learning plans for students.

Discussion about continuing to work towards connecting with and engaging parents to improve student learning.

### **Homeschooling Students:**

Discussion about home-schooling and extra-curricular activity. Can/should homeschool students be allowed to play on school teams. The school decision is to invite these kids to play on our teams, but a specific contract will be created for them.

**Fundraising:**

The SLC will not be doing the magazine fundraiser. Instead, the SLC will collect a \$25 fee from each student for student activities throughout the year.

The SLC is also considering making a community cookbook for a fundraiser. The SLC is looking for help from the SCC. The SCC is willing to support – we will discuss more in future meetings.

The school would like to work towards fundraising/purchasing an AED for the school.

**Movie Night:**

We are proposing a partnership with the SLC to work together for future Movie Nights.

**Plan for Future Meetings:**

We plan to meet on of September 11th, October 9th, November 6th, February 5th, March 4th, April 22 at 6pm. AGM planned for April 22nd.

**Report Cards:**

The staff is working through the new report cards. It will be, a learning curve for parents, students, and staff. The school will look into getting information sessions set up.

**Supporting the LIP:**

Discussion about how the SCC can support the LIP. The SCC is agreeing to support a My School Sask parent information night. Discussion about how to use/spend our money – goal is to get parents in the door. Talked about using money to bring in a speaker for parents (e.g. Jody Carrington) – we will discuss this in future meetings. We also talked about supporting hot lunch meals for the students – we will investigate this further.
