

CLOTHING EXPECTATIONS:

At CES we expect our students to maintain an acceptable standard of dress in school and in class. The school guidelines are as follows:

- 1) No clothing with profanity, offensive gestures or clothing promoting tobacco, alcohol or other drugs, etc.
- 2) Undergarments are not exposed.
- 3) Appropriate length of shirts (no crop tops or loose-fitting muscle shirts) and bottoms (shorts, skirts, dresses.)
- 4) Appropriate footwear.

Ultimately, we want our students to wear clothing that allows them to play and move about the school and playground in comfort and without exposure, and to wear clothing that is not offensive to others (profanity, promotion of drugs, etc.) School staff may ask students to change clothing that does not align with our expectations or provide alternate clothing to be worn for the school day. As with any school expectation, parents will be contacted if necessary.
