School Goals

Math

Primary: By June 2026, 85% of students will be developing as expected in the Numeracy Strand required by their math curriculum as outlined by the Ministry of Education (SaskMath & Sask Curriculum Guide)

Secondary: By June 2026, 90% of students will have grown in at least 3 math skills required by the math curriculum as outlined by the Ministry of Education (SaskMath)

Attendance

By June 2026 - our school-wide attendance rate will be 92%.

Reading

Primary: By June 30, 2026, 85% of students will read at grade level measured by Fountas and Pinnell and (grades 1-5).

Secondary: 90% of students in grades 1-5 will move up 2 reading levels as measured by Fountas and Pinnell (grades 1-5).

All students will be tested in the Reading level using F&P.
