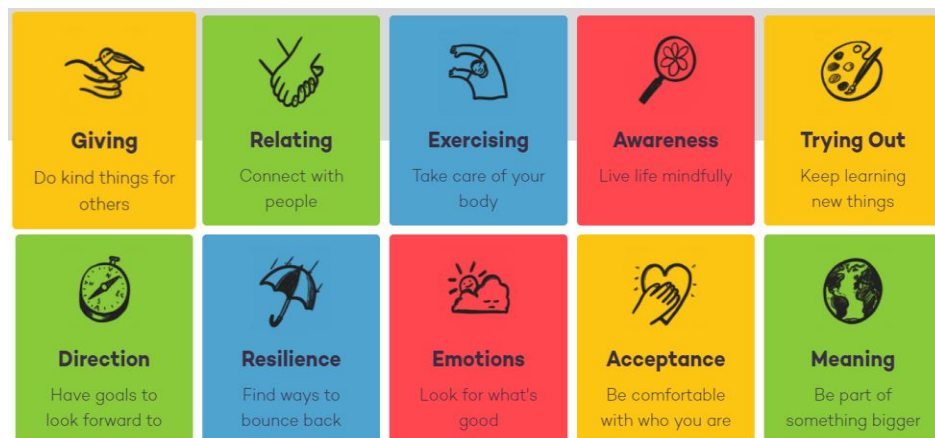

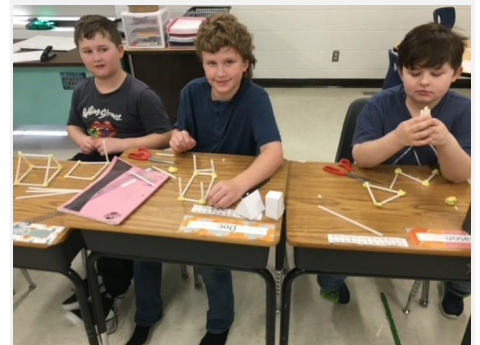
Graduation Meeting & Photography

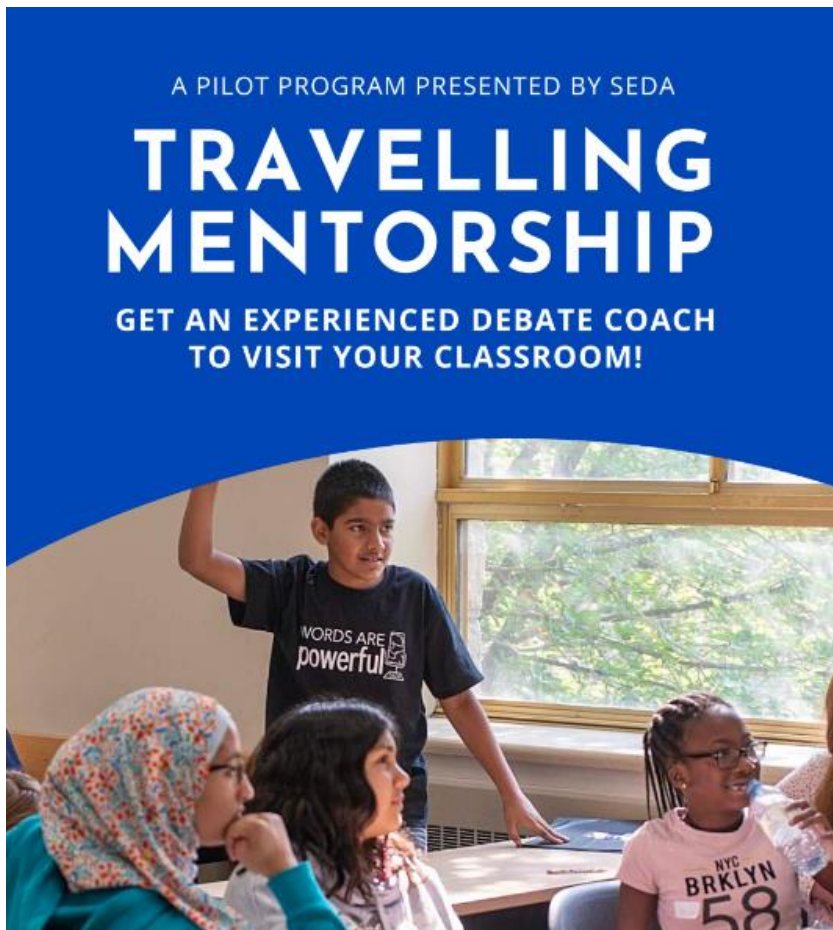
