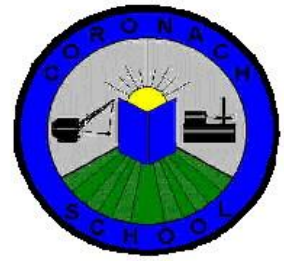


High School Report Cards

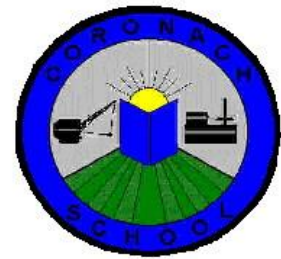

"Thrivers finish what they start & don't need gold stars".

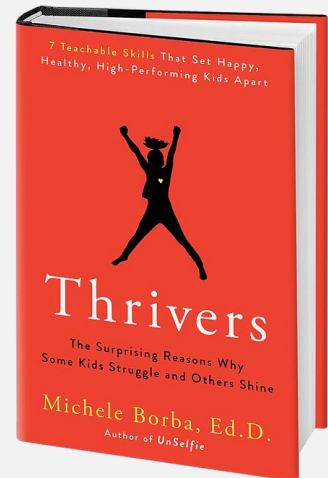

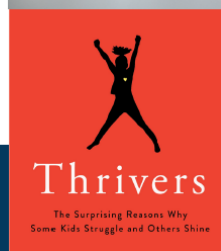
Trait 7 - Optimism

School Community Council Administrative Policies developed by the Board of Education regarding the elections can be viewed under the schools tab, School Community Councils section on the Prairie South Schools website: www.prairiesouth.ca

Parents and guardians of students attending Coronach School and School Division electors residing in the school catchment area may stand for election to the School Community Council and vote in the elections. The School Community Council is comprised of five to nine elected parents and community members. Elections are being held to fill these positions.

Nominations of parents and community members interested in standing for election must be submitted on the official form and will be received up to the time of the election. Nominations are available from Coronach School and can be returned to Coronach School prior to the election or be presented at the election.

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
