THRIVERS: Why Some Kids Struggle and Others Shine

This month as parents/guardians we challenge you to:

Help child identify stress signs or body warnings that alert you that you're losing control. Point out in context- louder talker, flushed checks, clenched fists-until child can identify her warnings, then teach how to cope, p 121.

Develop assertive comebacks that child can say in tough situations: "Not cool." "Cut it out." "I don't want to." Firm, short statements work best. Practice delivery using a firm-not wimpy-voice with head high, *p 240*.

This month as a school community we will be focusing on the character strength of **Perseverance**

"Thrivers finish what they start & don't need gold stars".

Perseverance: Exhibiting fortitude, tenacity, and the resolve to endure, to bounce back from failure, increase resolve to endure and develop personal agency.

Three abilities that nurture integrity: 1. Growth mind-set 2. Goal-setting 3. Learning from failure

Trait 6 - Perseverance

Summary

- Exhibiting fortitude, tenacity, and the resolve to endure, so as to bounce back from failure, increase resolve to endure and develop personal agency.
- Thrivers finish what they start and don't need gold stars.

Why it matters

- Students with a growth mind-set are more likely to endure, specially after the pandemic.
- Research says that the: "the ability to stick to a task and a long-term goal is the greatest predictor of success and stronger than IQ, academic achievement, SAT scores, extra- curricular activities and test


