Dear Parents and Guardians,

In multi-grade classrooms a variety of courses are occurring at one time. Prairie South Schools Division wants to ensure that you are aware of the outcome expectations for your child.

This letter is to inform you about curriculums that your child is receiving at Eyebrow School in the 2023-2024 school year.

Students in Grades 1-6 will be taking ELA, Arts Ed, PE and Math at their grade level. Grades 1 & 2 will be taking all other classes at the Grade 2 level but meeting their own grade outcome. Grade 3 & 4 students will take all classes at the Grade 4 level but meeting their own grade outcomes. Grade 5 & 6 will be taking all other subjects at Grade 5 but meeting their own grade outcomes.
