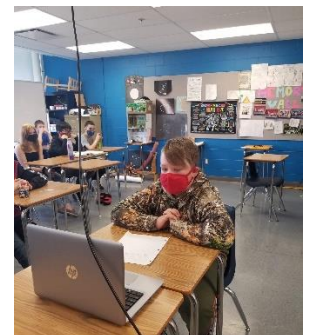
The 100th Day of School
