Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation (STF) has been engaged in contract negotiations with the Government-Trustee Bargaining Committee, and the STF announced that teachers have voted in favour of sanctions, or job action.

This morning, we received 48 hours' notice from the STF regarding a provincewide strike by all STF members. In the memo we received it states:

"On Tuesday, January 16, 2024, there will be a provincewide strike by all members of the STF. All Federation members will withdraw all professional and voluntary services for the entire day. STF members will not report to nor enter their place of work."

As such, all Prairie South schools will be closed on Tuesday, January 16, 2024. Please ensure your child(ren) do not attend school that day. All school-related activities for that day will also be cancelled. School and school-related activities will resume on Wednesday, January 17.

While we hope for a timely resolution to this issue, it is important to remember that this is a Provincial dispute arising from Provincial Bargaining. As such, we are continuing to work with all our employees to manage this job action in a safe and responsible manner that minimizes the impact on students.
