School life has resumed full force and we are back into our groove. Our SCC met this week and have helped align and approve our goals for the upcoming year. With data from the Our School survey and direction from the province and division, we have decided to work on the following two goals:

**1) By June 2023, every student in grades 1-6 will increase at least two benchmark levels, as measured by Fountas and Pinnell.**

**2) By June 2023, 100% of our students will have received information on emotions and coping strategies. By June 2023, 80% of our students will be able to identify at least 3 coping strategies to reduce anxiety and improve their mental health.**

I would like to thank the SCC members this year who have committed to working with the school, helping improve our school, and volunteering their time.
