Just a friendly reminder to keep reading with your child. Continue sharing good stories and practicing those reading skills.



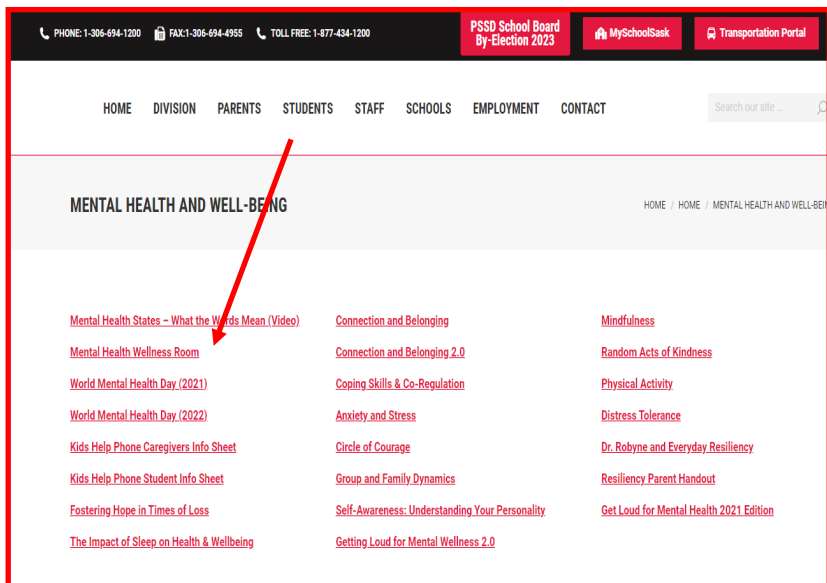
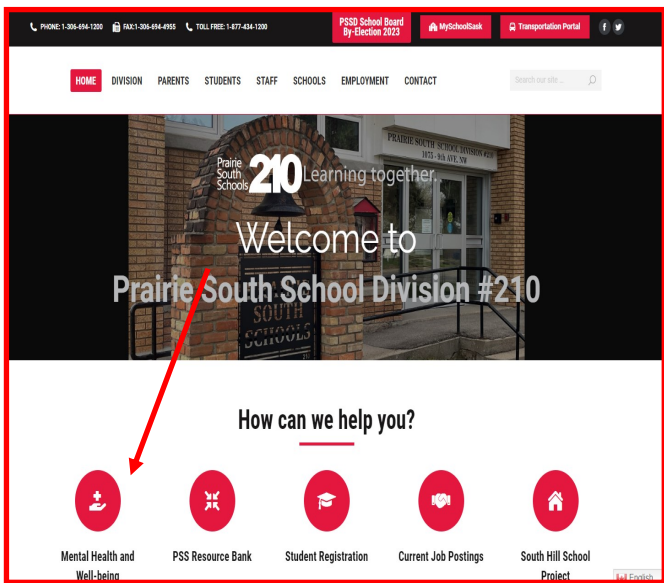

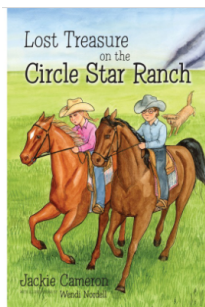
