

Student immunization records in Grade 1, 6 & 8 are confidentially reviewed each year using the provincial immunization registry called Panorama by authorized public health team members.

During 2023-2024 school year consent forms will be sent to all:

- Grade 1 students requiring completion of Preschool vaccines.
- Grade 6 students requiring Hepatitis B, Meningococcal & Human Papillomavirus vaccines.
- Grade 8 students requiring a booster doses of Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (whooping cough).

Parents are to complete the consent forms and return to school as soon as possible. Call Assiniboia Public Health at 306-642-2200 if you have questions.
