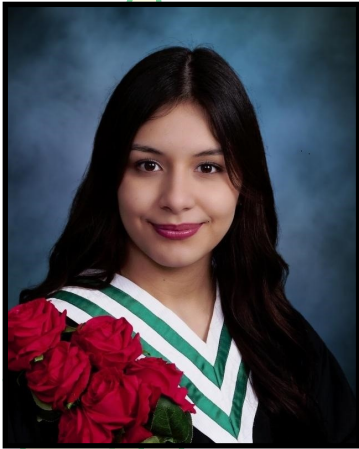

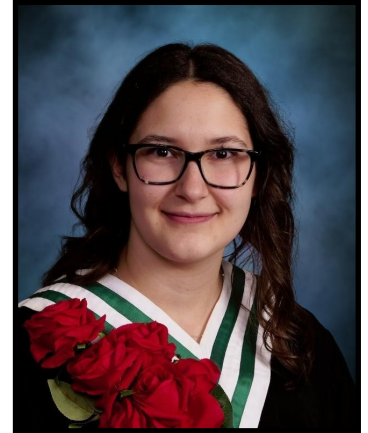

Future Plans: Emma plans to attend the University of Regina to study business administration and major in accounting.



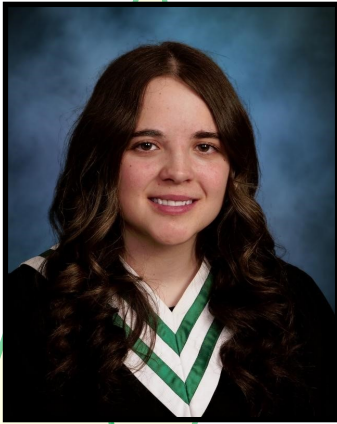

Future Plans: Kaydance plans to go to Las Vegas, put everything on red and see where life goes.

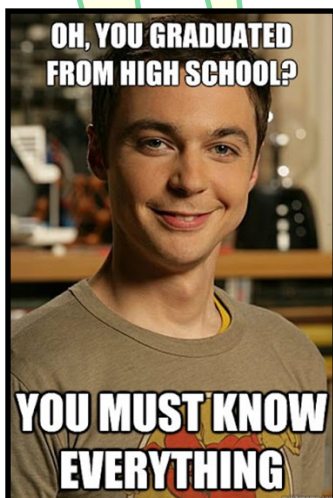

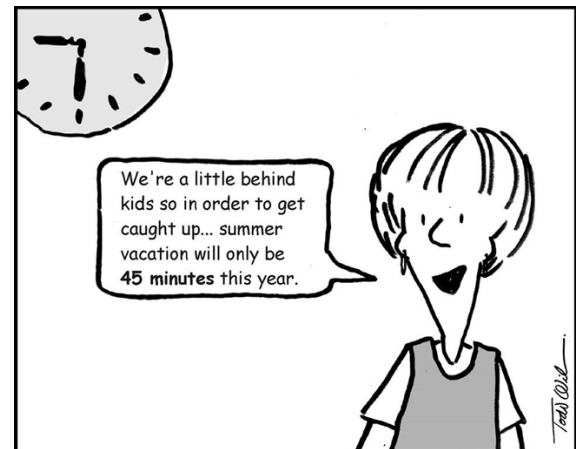
