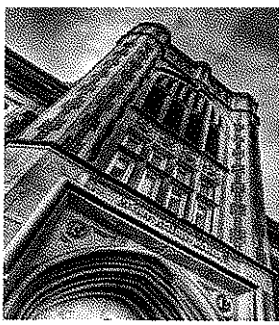

School Goals:

By June 30, 2020, 75% (?) of grade 1-8 students will **read and comprehend** at grade level as measured by Fountas and Pinnell (grades 1-4) and Basic Reading Inventory (grades 5-8)

By June 30, 2020, 80% of grade 1-8 students will achieve grade level outcomes in **math** using achievement data from the Saskatchewan Curricular Outcomes.

By June 30, 2020, 80% of students in grades 1 – 8 will be **writing** at a proficient level (3) or above level based on the Ministry of Education's Holistic Writing Rubrics.

By June 30, 2020, 80% of grade 1-8 students will report that they **feel safe** at school as measured by the OurSchool Survey and teacher made assessment.
