

Mathematics Courses

You are required to take one math at the 10 level and one math at the 20 level to graduate.

There are three strands for mathematics:

1. Workplace and Apprenticeship

- Content is geared towards math in the workplace and real-world settings.
- Content in this pathway is designed for students intending to pursue careers in the trades and general workplaces.

2. Pre-Calculus

- Content is geared towards math related careers (ex. engineering).
- Content in this pathway is designed for students interested in pursuing careers in science-related areas.

3. Foundations of Mathematics

- Content in this pathway is designed for students interested in pursuing careers in areas that typically require university, although not math intensive (ex. humanities, fine arts, social sciences, and nursing).
