Kindergarten & Prekindergarten Registrations & Applications NOW OPEN!

Prairie South is excited to welcome new Kindergarten students to the 2023-2024 school year!

Prekindergarten is an application process not a registration process. Families will be contacted by the school in June to discuss their application.

Children must be 5 years of age by December 31, 2023 to register for kindergarten.

Children must be 3 or 4 years old by the time school starts in the fall to apply for prekindergarten.

Kindergarten and Grade 1 Registrations

Please look at the following procedures for registering children in Kindergarten and Grade 1.

- a) Children who are five years of age as of December 31 (born in 2018) may be admitted to Kindergarten for the 2024-24 school year.
- b) Children who meet Ministry of Education criteria for a student with a designated disability may enter a school-division early learning program no earlier than the age of three, provided the Director of Education has approved such an admission.
- c) Children who are six years of age as of December 31 (born in 2017) are to be admitted to grade one for the 2023-24 school year.
