Our school bell rings at 8:45 am. This is the beginning of outdoor supervision of our students and when busses arrive for the day. Students will enter their doors when the bell rings at 9 am and proceed to their classrooms. If you do not know where to go, please go to the front doors and someone will assist you. This is where students need to go:

Kindergarten- meet at the kindergarten doors on the North side of our building
Grade 1's- meet behind the school at the grade 1 doors (right by the playgrounds)
Grade 2 and 3"s - enter the doors on the North side of the building by the YMCA daycare doors.
Grades 4-8- enter the doors by the bike racks or by the staff parking lot
Bus students will meet the supervisor getting off the bus and they will direct them to the appropriate doors. Pre kindergarten, Kindergarten and grade 1 students will walk with Mrs.
Alexander to buses at the end of the day.
