1. **Meeting called to order @ 7:02 pm.**
2. Motion made by Darren to adopt the agenda. 2nd by Charlyn.
3. Motion made by to adopt the minutes from the Oct. 8 meeting by Charlyn and Darren 2nd.
4. Financial Report –\$1522 from the board office grant, does not include 2 popcorn days and the Halloween dance. We will get the total next meeting.
5. Principals Report – Dave
 - 452 students
 - Grizzly clothing order was approx. \$3000, it will be here for x-mas. \$2 from every item goes to the SCC. We will possibly order again in the spring.
 - Outdoor classroom, they are just waiting for the cheque from the Sunningdale/VLA Association. They need to tender the building process. They are hoping to build in the spring.
 - Safety patrol now has 40 kids, good attendance so far. A sponsorship letter was written and handed out for some incentives for the kids.
 - Another handicap parking spot will be added for a total of 3. MMS
 - My School Sask (MSS), will have the parent portal ready to log in on November 21. They are having issues with getting it up and going. It will be Sask. wide. Prairie South is one of the first to try it. Report card will be on there now, no more paper copies.
 - Student Wellness Survey went well, only a few kids in the school mentioned for bullying, 2 names were mentioned twice.
 - The Halloween Dance was AWESOME!! The Remembrance Day display was done by Aaron Ubell, great job.

NEW BUSINESS

1) Staff/SCC lunch

4) Lunch Fundraisers

- Cathy has looked into BP's for pizza and pasta. Pizza would be a 6" for \$3 or 8" for \$5. Choices are Cheese, Ham, Pepperoni or Hawaiian. Gluten free is available and all options come with a juice box. Pasta was discussed but the concern was would the kids still eat it if it's not hot when they get it. You could possibly split the school and do K-odd to Grade 4 one day and then K-even and 5-8 the next day. Options are penne or spaghetti (gluten free option available) sauce choices are marinara (tomato), alfredo, bolognese (meat sauce) and comes with a juice box for \$4.

- There was a discussion to possibly have a Subway lunch on December 17. The prices for Subway are 6" for \$5 or a 12" for \$8 and both come with a juice box. Choices are brown/white bread or gluten free option (6"), orange or white cheese, cold cut trio, turkey or ham. Cathy talked to Cheanne at the Thatcher location. We will confirm at the next meeting. They need a week's notice for an order. Dave will check for a Subway order form.
